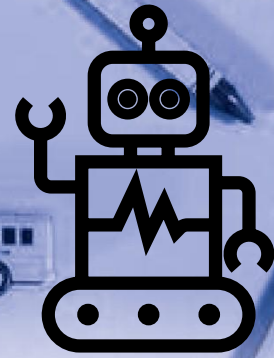
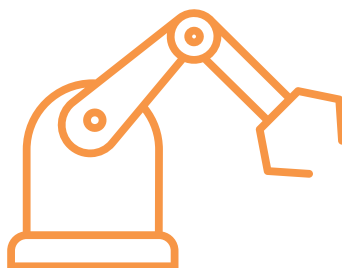

Robot Kit

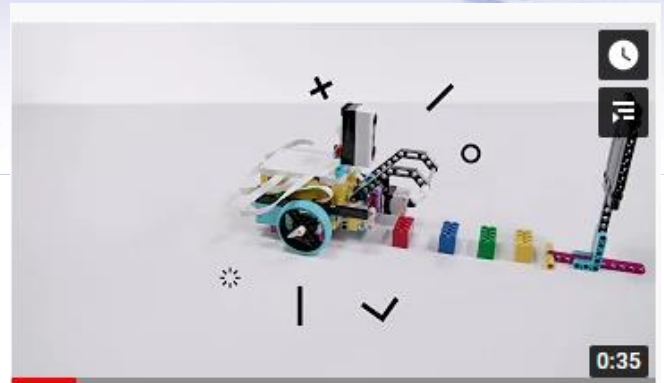

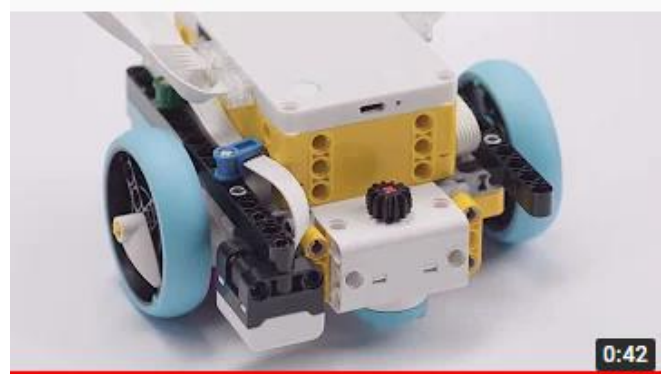

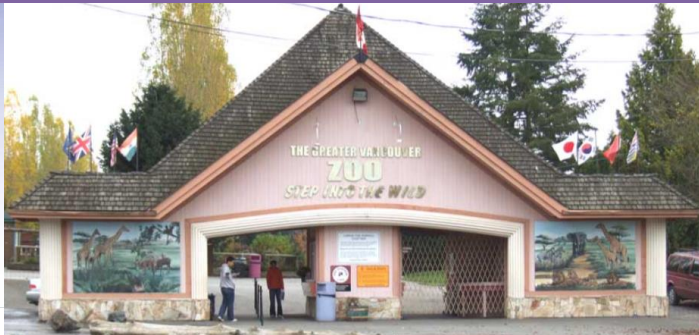

REMEMBER THE HEALTH CHECK APP!



There is a new daily health check app that the BC government has recently put out. Please go to <https://www.k12dailycheck.gov.bc.ca/healthcheck?execution=e1s1>

At GLA students and Staff will strictly adhere to the following COVID-19 regulations and protocols:

- Staff, Students, and Guests will be screened for temperature readings upon entering the building (voluntary). We ask that anyone showing symptoms stay at home and please report symptoms to the school.
- Students will be required to wear a mask, when social distancing cannot be maintained, however spaces in the class will be designed for safe distancing.
- We will follow public health guidelines and protocols as changes are required throughout the school year.
- We will have air purifiers in the rooms to remove bacteria, viruses, dust, etc.
- The school has a supply of one-time use face masks for students needing them during the day in case they forget theirs at home, if they come down with a fever during the school day, or they are not feeling well. Families will be notified for pick up.
- We will teach and practice regular hand washing.
- We will also have hand sanitizer at the school.
- Students will bring individual supplies and a supply box, and shared items will be reduced. These items will be cleaned when shared.
- We will have enhanced cleaning of the school building and physical movement supplies. We will be asking for volunteers to help with this cleaning process.
